Level 2 – Pyramid of Interventions

Teacher Interventions

- Give encouragement and positive attention
- Review CUM folder in counseling office
- Personal conference with student
- Change seating
- Parent contact by phone, e-mail or conference
- Refer student to tracking program
- Assign an in-class buddy/peer tutor
- Provide before/after school help
- Confer with grade level team or current teachers
- Grade level team schedule a parent meeting
- Sign planner daily
- Provide a tracking sheet for student and parent
- Advisory teacher mentor a student
- Teacher/student contract

Level 3 – Pyramid of Interventions

Counselor/Administration Interventions

- Written Referral to ARM committee
- Schedule change
- Follow-up on interventions by teachers
- Parent conference/contact
- Counselor Watch List (monitor grades, attendance & assignments)
- Send letter regarding credit remediation options (9th grade)
- Academic Success Group
- English make-up class (9th grade)
- Testing and Placement in Special Programs
- 504 Accommodation Plan

- Retention Programs
- Outside Academic Referrals
- Other school placement
