## LEVEL 3

Teacher Conference with parents; Student/Parent Behavior Plan Contract; Student/Teacher Contract; Counselor Watch List; Academic Groups; Esteem Team Assistance; ISS (In School Suspension)

## LEVEL 2

Mid-Term Deficiency Notices; Individual Academic Tracking; Student Service Center; Individual Attendance Tracking; Credit Lost Letter – 9<sup>th</sup> grade; After School Tutoring (M&M Tutoring); Parent Contact (by Teacher, Counselor, Administrator); Teacher/Counselor contact to Student/Parent; Working with teacher before and after school, 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Teaming,
